Information you need to know

Included with your registration:

Two overnights, unlimited beer supply, plenty of wine, a giveaway or two, a light meal late Friday, breakfast & lunch on Saturday & Sunday, dinner on Saturday, mineral water, THE view, runs, unlimited amount of UP (don't forget Bern H3 never runs out of UP!).

Venue

The Hotel Mon Repos is a HOSTEL! <http://www.groups.ch/en/haeuserdetail.php?id=3786>

IMPORTANT: No dirty shoes allowed in the venue. BRING YOUR SLIPPERS! There is also NO SMOKING in the venue – it's made of wood so all smoking must be outdoors!

There are rooms with multiple-beds and space for tents. Registration is limited to 100 hashers. Rooms will be assigned / designated so state your roommate preference when registering. There are no double rooms left, so don't ask. All others will be in multiple-bed rooms (couples sharing with other couples - either 2 or 3 couples to a room). There will be a SNORING room too. FYI – there is one 12 bed room and one 10 bed room; all other rooms are 8 bed rooms or smaller.

If you are staying in the venue (not camping) you *do not need to bring* sheets or pillows or pillowcases.

Check out of the rooms at 10:45 on Sunday. Bags can be stored in the venue in a designated room. Showers will be available after the Hangover Hash and circle.

How to get to the venue? 61740 E 14788 N or 46 29.241N 7 39.922E (lat/long)

By car: Type Kandersteg into an online map and look for Inneri Hauptstrasse. The Hotel Mon Repos is on the left hand side, just past the underpass for the train tracks. There is a KIOSK first and then the entry to the car park. *Please don't park in the reserved spot for the beer van!*

By train: Check your individual schedules at www.sbb.ch . The venue is about 2 km from the station if you don't mind the walk. There is also a bus. Or, let us know when you are arriving and the Beer Van will meet you. Driver: BeerBra +41 76 / 408-3998.
